ON FEBRUARY 11, 1981, [REDACTED] A SOURCE OF PROVEN RELIABILITY, ADVISED THAT HE OVERHEARD TWO UNKNOWN SUBJECTS IN THE BOAR'S HEAD RESTAURANT, 127 E. BROAD ST., FALLS CHURCH, VIRGINIA, DISCUSSING WHAT MAY BE A PLOT TO ASSASSINATE PRIME MINISTER THATCHER. SOURCE ADVISED THAT THE UNSUBS, WHITE MALES, SPOKE WITH ENGLISH OR IRISH ACCENTS. THE SEGMENTS OF THE CONVERSATION SOURCE WAS ABLE TO OVERHEAR WENT AS FOLLOWS:

ON FEBRUARY 11, 1981, SPECIAL AGENT [ ] INTELLIGENCE DIVISION, U. S. SECRET SERVICE, WAS ADVISED OF THE ABOVE INFORMATION. SA [ ] ADVISED THAT PRIME MINISTER THATCHER IS DUE TO VISIT THE UNITED STATES ON FEBRUARY 25, 1981. HER EXACT TRAVEL PLANS HAVE YET TO BE MADE, BUT SHE IS SCHEDULED TO STAY AT THE WALDORF-ASTORIA HOTEL IN NEW YORK CITY DURING HER VISIT. SA [ ] FURTHER ADVISED THAT "H" PROBABLY STANDS FOR H BLOCK IN BELFAST MAZE PRISON, A BRITISH PRISON WHERE IRA SUSPECTS ARE HELD. HE ADVISED THAT A GROUP CALLED THE "SQUASH H COMMITTEE" HAS RECENTLY SURFACED AT GEORGETOWN UNIVERSITY IN WASHINGTON, D. C., BUT ITS MEMBERS ARE LARGELY UNKNOWN.

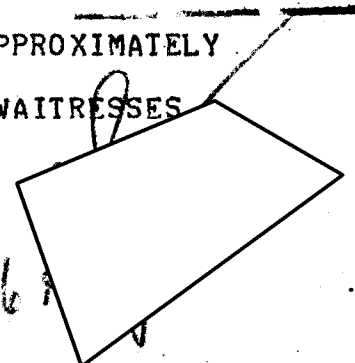

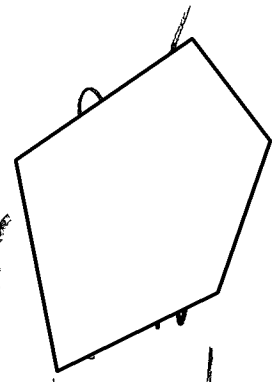

At 9:30 p.m. on 2/11/81, source overheard two men sitting near him in the restaurant talking. The source could only hear one man's conversation. This person spoke with a British or Irish

New York Office has advised that ~~an~~ anti-Thatcher demonstration is scheduled for 2/28/81, between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the Waldorf - Astoria Hotel in New York City. It is noted that Prime Minister Thatcher will be at the Waldorf - Astoria Hotel that date. The demonstration is being coordinated by [REDACTED].
