- 2 -SECRET In giving the above account, the Prime Minister said that she found it significant that Deng had told Y.K. Pao as much as he had. Clearly, the Chinese were using him to give wider currency to the plan which Deng had announced to her. I am copying this letter to Sir Edward Youde in Hong Kong and Sir Percy Cradock in Peking. The Governor, Sir Philip Haddon-Cave and Alan Donald were present when the Prime Minister described her talk with Y.K. Pao. There should therefore be limited need for further circulation of this letter. I should be grateful if you would ensure, as with all records on this subject, that this letter is circulated only to those who have a clear need to know.
