When the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary called on the Prime Minister this morning he informed her that Mr. Edward Heath, M.P. would be visiting Peking on 30 August and raised the question of whether Mr. Heath should be given a briefing about our negotiations with the Chinese on the question of Hong Kong.

It was agreed that it would be appropriate for such a briefing to be provided and the Prime Minister asked the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary to make suitable arrangements.
