## DISCUSSION WITH EXCO

1. H DISCUSSED THE CURRENT POSITION IN THE TALKS WATH EXCO ON 14 SEPTEMBER. H HAD WARNED THEM ON 13 SEPTEMBER THAT HE WOULD BE SEEKING THEIR VIEWS AND HAD CHRCULATED COPIES OF THE PAPER HAN YOUR SECOND TUR. THE OUTLANDE OF THE DRAFT OPENING STATEMENT FOR 22 SEPTEMBER HAN YOUR TELNO 896. AND A SUMMARY OF THE MAIN POINTS MADE BY THE CHINESE HIN THE COVERSATHONS BETWEEN ZHOU NAN AND MR CLARK (PEKHING TELNO 812), US SENATORS HATCH AND ZORHNSKY AND FOREIGN MINHSTER WU XUEQHAN (PHERCE'S TELELETTER OF 7 SEPTEMBER) AND MR HEATH AND DENG XHAOPHING (PEKHING TELNO 879). THE COUNCIL CLEARLY WELCOMED THIS OPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS THE POSITION REACHED AND ALTHOUGH THE MEETING WAS LONG (THREE AND A HALF HOURS) MEMBERS WISHED TO PURSUE THE DISCUSSION FURTHER BEFORE THE TALKS IN PEKING RESUME NEXT WEEK. IN HAVE ARRANGED A FURTHER MEETHING FOR TOMORROW EVENING (LOCAL THME). YOU MAY NEVERTHELESS FHAD HET USEFUL TO HAVE AN ACCOUNT OF THE MAIN POINTS TODAY.

- 2. AN MATRODUCING THE SUBJECT IN SPOKE AS MASTRUCTED AN YOUR FARST TUR, ADDING THAT WHILE DENG'S REMARKS TO MR HEATH DAD NOT CHANGE OUR VIEW OF THE LAME WHICH THE BRATASH TEAM SHOULD TAKE ON 22/23 SEPTEMBER, THEY DAD REMAFORCE THE ASSESSMENT OF THE CHANESE POSITION.
- 3. AS REGARDS THE POINT IN PARA 2(A) OF YOUR FARST TUR. THERE WAS A REASONABLE CONSENSUS THAT A STALEMATE OR BREAKDOWN HIN THE TALKS WOULD CARRY SERHOUS RHSKS FOR THE HONG KONG DOLLAR, AND THAT HET WOULD ACCELERATE PREPARATHONS FOR DEPARTURE AMONG THOSE IN A POSITION TO LEAVE HONG KONG. THERE WAS ALSO AGREEMENT THAT THE EXTENT OF THE DAMAGE TO CONFIDENCE WOULD DEPEND HAN PART ON THE CHRCUMSTANCES HIN WHACH THE STALEMATE OR BREAKDOWN OCCURRED AND THE WAY HAN WHACH HET WAS PRESENTED BY THE TWO SHIDES. SOME MEMBERS BELHEVED THAT THE CHANESE WOULD COOPERATE AN PRESENTING AN AGREEMENT TO DIFFER IN A NEUTRAL WAY (" A FRIENDLY PARTING OF THE WAYS" OR ''A PAUSE FOR REFLECTMON'') AND TOOK THE VIEW THAT. IN THAT EVENT, THE CONSEQUENCES FOR CONFIDENCE WOULD BE LESS SERIOUS. SOME ALSO FELT THAT THE CONSEQUENCES FOR CONFIDENCE OF A STALEMATE OR BREAKDOWN, WOULD HAVE TO BE ACCEPTED NO MATTER HOW SER HOUS THEY MINGHT BE. OTHERS WERE MORE CONSCHOUS OF THE RISK THAT THE CHINESE MIGHT PLAY ROUGH, AND DECIDE FORMALLY TO ANNOUNCE THEIR PLAN.

/4. IT

4. LT WAS THE GENERAL VIEW THAT THE BRITTISH TEAM SHOULD SEEK TO AVOID A BREAKDOWN ON 22/23 SEPTEMBER, PROVIDE THIS COULD BE DONE WITHOUT CONCEDING ESSENTHAL PRINCHPLES, AND SHOULD IF NECESSARY LEAVE THE CHINESE HAN NO DOUBT OF THE CONSEQUENCES OF A BREAKDOWN OF A CONFRONTATHONAL KIND. THERE WAS AGREEMENT ON THE NEED TO GIVE CAREFUL THOUGHT TO THE WAY HAN WHINCH ANY HANTERRUPTHON OF THE TALKS MAGHT BE PRESENTED PUBLICLY BY HMG AND THE HKG WHENEVER OF OCCURED.

5. HAN DHISCUSSINON OF POSSIBLE COURSES OF ACTION SHOULD THE CHANESE MANTAIN THEMR PRESENT HARD LANE, THERE WAS NO SUPPORT FOR THE OPTHON SET OUT MAN PARA 10 OF YOUR TELNO 880 AT LEAST AT THUS STAGE. THE VHEW WAS EXPRESSED THAT TO OFFER ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES WOULD WEAKEN THE BRATTISH NEOGOTHATING POSHTLION WITHOUT GAMMING ANYTHING HIN RETURN.

6. A NUMBER OF MEMBERS SUGGESTED, ON THEMR OWN HANTHATHIVE AND WHITHOUT PROMPTHING, THAT THE BEST TACTHICS MIGHT BE TO TELL THE CHANESE THAT OUR OWN VAEW WAS STALL THAT THAT CONTINUING BRUTISH ADMINISTRATION WAS NECESSARY TO CONFUDENCE, BUT AT THE SAME THME HINVETE THEM TO DEVELOP AND PROVIDE FURTHER DETAHLS OF THEME OWN PLAN AND PARTHCULARLY ON WHAT GUARANTEES THEY WOULD BE PREPARED TO OFFER.

7. SHR S Y CHUNG THOUGHT THAT THERE WERE OTHER OPTHONS THAT COULD BE CONSHIDERED, E.G. SEEKING AN EXTENSION OF BRITISH ADMINISTRATION FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME, BUT HE HAD NOT DEVELOPED THESE FULLY. THE COUNCIL SHOWED LATTLE MINTEREST HIN THEM.

8. WHEN THE COUNCIL RESUMES ATS DISCUSSION TOMORROW AT HIS LAKELY THAT MEMBERS WILL PURSUE FURTHER THE HIDEA HIN PARA 6 ABOVE AND ALSO FOCUS ON THE QUESTION OF OUR PUBLIC RELATIONS STANCE. THEY ARE MUCH CONCERNED ABOUT THE EFFECT WHICH OUR PRESENT SHEENCE HIS HAVING ON THE MORALE OF THE COMMUNITY HIN HONG KONG. YOUDE
