WELSH CONFERENCE: SATURDAY, 23rd JUNE 1984

1. You have agreed to address the Welsh Conference on Saturday, 23rd June 1984.
2. It would therefore be logical for you to do a Welsh regional tour the day before, Friday, 22nd June.
3. The Welsh tour planned for this year was cancelled because of the Election.
4. Your long term diary may show this Friday (22nd June) committed to Finchley. I have talked to Joy and Caroline who assure me that this is simply one of the days allotted to Finchley but for which no programme yet exists, and another day for Finchley can therefore be found.
5. Friday, 22nd June is therefore available for the Welsh tour.
6. However, you will be in Paris for the European Council on Monday 25th June and Tuesday 26th June.
7. But unless you do a regional tour on the Friday proposed it may be difficult to find another day and Wales will then have missed two years running.
8. Would you like to do the Welsh regional tour on Friday, 22nd June?
