1. AGENCY REPORTS OF PRESIDENT MITTERPAND'S STATEMENT IN THE HAGUE THAT FRANCE IS MAKING FRESH MOVES AT THE UN TO ALLOW THE REPLACEMENT OF THE MNF IN LEBANON WITH UN TROOPS AND THAT SUCH MOVES HAVE BEEN UNDER WAY ''IN THE LAST FEW HOURS'' HAVE CAUSED MUCH INTEREST HERE. UNDER SECRETARY GENERAL URQUHART ASKED US THIS EVENING WHETHER WE COULD EXPLAIN WHAT LAY BEHIND IT. WE QUOTED TO HIM FROM PARIS TELNO 149. URQUHART SAID THAT NEITHER HE NOR THE SECRETARY GENERAL HAD HEARD ANYTHING FROM THE FRENCH THOUGH AMBASSADOR DE NANTEUIL

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2. URQUHART SAID THAT HE WAS ANXIOUS TO PROTECT PEREZ DE CUELLAR, WHOSE INSTINCT WAS TO TRY TO BE OBLIGING, FROM BEING CAUGHT BY SOME '*GRANDSTAND PLOY'' BY THE FRENCH. IN PRESENT CIRCUMSTANCES IN BEIRUT THERE WAS NO QUESTION OF THE INSERTION OF A UN FORCE. NOT ONLY WAS IT DOUBTFUL THAT THERE WAS ANY LONGER A CONSTITUTIONAL AUTHORITY OF SUFFICIENT WEIGHT TO INVITE THE UN IN, BUT TROOP CONTRIBUTORS WOULD BE UNWILLING TO RISK THE LIVES OF THEIR MEN (OF THE CONTRIBUTORS TO UNIFIL HE THOUGHT THAT ONLY THE FIJIANS MIGHT BE PREPARED TO VOLUNTEER). IN HIS VIEW THE MOST USEFUL DIPLOMATIC MOVE THAT FRENCH COULD MAKE WOULD BE TO PROVIDE A FRAMEWORK WITHIN WHICH THE AMERICANS COULD TALK TO THE RUSSIANS. 3. URQUHART SIAD THAT PEREZ DE CUELLAR HAD CALLED IN THE RUSSIAN AMBASSADOR TO DISCUSS THE SITUATION. TROYANOVSKY HAD BEEN EVASIVE WITHOUT BEING TOTALLY NEGATIVE. HE HAD CLAIMED IGNORANCE OF ANY FRENCH INITIATIVE.

4. THE FRENCH MISSION HERE TELL US THAT THEIR INFORMATION IS CONFINED TO AGENCY REPORTS, THAT THEY HAVE NO INSTRUCTIONS AND THAT DE NANTEUIL CHECKED THE REPORTS WITH THE QUAL BUT OBTAINED NO CLARIFICATION.

5. PEREZ DE CUELLAR ISSUED À SHORT STATEMENT TODAY EXPRESSING HIS DEEP ANXIETY ABOUT THE SITUATION BUT MAKING CLEAR THAT THE UN WAS NOT DIRECTLY INVOLVED. URQUHART REMAINS OF THE VIEW THAT THERE IS NOTHING THE UN CAN DO AT PRESENT ''TO REDEEM THIS TRIBAL MESS''.
