(Resolutions received from Constituency, Area and other organisations)

1. Withdrawal of Rail Services

"This Committee is concerned at the reports of withdrawal of Rail Services, both passanger and freight, west of Taunton, in view of the great importance to the economy and the life of the South west and calls upon the Government to ensure that the interests of the South West are protected."

Carried unanimously at a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Western Area Council at which there were 37 members present.

2. Voting rights to Britons abroad

"This Conference welcomes the forthcoming extension of voting rights to Britons abroad, but regrets the proposed seven-year cut-off limit and recommends that it be removed for British citizens resident in countries of the European Community."

3. Extending the Franchise to British citizens resident abroad

"This Association, while welcoming the promised legislation on extending the franchise to British citizens resident abroad, opposes the proposal to limit this to those who have been registered in the U.K. during the past seven years. In this Association's view, the franchise should be extended to all British citizens who have the right of abode in the U.K. and that they should have the right to vote in the constituency where they last lived or where their parents last resided."

Carried unanimously by the Executive Committee of the British Conservative Association in Switzerland.

4. Preventive Medicine and Health Education

"This Conference urges greater awareness in the field of preventive medicine and urges the Government to continue in its endeavours to give increasing importance to preventive and health education."
