PERSONAL MESSAGE SERIAL No. TIZZA 84 11th July 1984 The Rt Hon Mrs Margaret Thatcher MP Prime Minister Following our telephone conversation today and my discussions with our colleagues about the establishment of the committees mentioned in the Presidency Conclusions of our meeting in Fontainebleau, I would propose that the terms of reference of the high level committee on the further development of the Community should be -"To consider and make recommendations to the European Council on the extension and deepening of European integration, and for that purpose to examine (1) The possibility of extending the competence of the Community in relation to education, culture, health, justice and the fight against terrorism, and the technological future of Europe, and of developing the European Monetary System. (2) The functioning and decision-making arrangements of the institutions and the inter-relationships between them." I would propose that Senator James Dooge, who is Government Leader in the Senate and a former Minister for Foreign Affairs, would Chair the Committee for the duration of its work, and that the Head of State or Government of each country would each nominate a representative, as could the Commission. I would envisage that the members of the Committee would be persons of high political standing. I would intend asking the Secretary General of the Council to ensure the provision of the necessary Secretariat for the Committee, which would normally meet in Brussels. I am writing to you to request your agreement to these proposed arrangements as soon as possible and to ask you to nominate the person whom you would propose to act as your representative on the Committee. 1 . . .
